# RULES, REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES

***PLEASE READ AND UNDERSTAND ALL RULES  
AS THERE MAY BE CHANGES FROM LAST YEAR!***

Entries must be from Beauregard Parish or "Ward Nine" (Rosepine). Exhibitors must live in Beauregard Parish or Ward 9 or must attend a Beauregard Parish School and animals must be housed in Beauregard Parish or Ward 9 in order to be eligible to show at the Beauregard Parish Fair. Every animal must be housed with the exhibitor.

All animals entered in the show must have been in the exhibitors' possession and care no later than October 1st of the current fair year.

**Poultry Testing - Birds MUST be tested prior to entry. Birds cannot be shown without testing of flock/bird. Testing will be done September 21, 2025, 1:00-5:00 pm and September 22, 2025 3:00-7:00 pm.**

Youth or Junior shall be defined as any exhibitor meeting 4-H or FFA membership age requirements or younger.

It is the exhibitor's or parent's responsibility to enter the animal, showmanship, and other contests; and to get prospect and/or market animals weighed at the designated times.

Animals not properly cared for may be disqualified.

Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their animals.

All animals will be exhibited in the Show Ring by the Exhibitor of Record except Tie Rack Cattle, an exhibitor having more than one animal to exhibit in a class, or the exhibitor becomes ill.

No single animal may be exhibited more than once, except for champion drives and showmanship.

Prospect or Market classes for sheep, goats, or swine are for females and castrated males. (NO INTACT MALES).

Market goats must be dehorned, disbudded or polled. Any scurs or horn structuring must be blunt and not exceed one inch in length. Goats not meeting dehorning requirements shall be placed in commercial class.

**ALL RABBITS MUST BE TATOED.**

All market goats and sheep must not show evidence of permanent incisors.

Bucks/ Rams must be registered but will not be allowed on grounds until Saturday morning.

Market Animals entered in the State Fair of Louisiana (must provide verification) must be registered but does not barn until 5 pm on Friday, October 3, 2025 and must remain until designated release time on Saturday night.

All animals used in showmanship must have been entered and/or shown in the Youth Division.

Peewee/Adult Showmanship will be included in each species. They may exhibit an animal entered by another youth or entered by themselves in the BPF.

**ANYONE CAUGHT STEALING ANIMALS FROM THE BEAUREGARD FAIR WILL BE PROSECUTED TO THE FULLEST!**

Registration Papers are required for all registered animals. Papers must be present when registering animals.

**Livestock wristbands will be issued for all species except Rabbits. Rabbit exhibitors will be given passes, if rabbits are required to stay, Livestock wristbands will be given.**

**MAX of 4 bands/passes per family.**

**No hay (including hay bags) is allowed in the barn.** Tie racks are provided outside the barn, for exhibitor use.

Feeding and watering of cattle must be done outside at the tie racks or even in the wash rack if need be.

All cattle should be back in the barn by 5:00 pm each evening, so that fairgoers can view them. After all, these are the people who pay to get into the fair and this is the money that is used to pay the livestock premiums.

**No dogs allowed in the barn.**

Groom animals in the designated areas. Do not groom animals in the tie areas. All grooming equipment, feed buckets and water buckets, and other items must be removed from the aisles before 5 PM nightly.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to clean up their pens and tie-spaces. The Fair will provide trash cans to help in keeping the barn clean.

Do not put manure in the trash cans. It goes outside to the area designated for it. Wheelbarrows and shovels will be provided by the Beauregard Fair Association to haul the manure.

All animals, to be admitted to the fairgrounds, must be free of infections, parasites, and appear to be in good health and vitality. Upon examination, animals that reveal symptoms of infectious, contagious, or parasitic disease, including external parasites such as mange, mites, lice, etc. shall be removed from the barn.

All show animals must have current health papers issued by a licensed veterinarian and meet the health rules and regulations as set down by the Louisiana Department of Agriculture, Livestock Sanitary Board. Health papers and animals are subject to be inspected by Livestock Sanitary officials before unloading. This includes Poultry and Rabbits.

Judges AND Show Manager Decisions are final.

By entering animals in the fair, you consent to follow the code of conduct and rules set forth by the Beauregard Parish Fair.
